

Rules

Except for Breeders teams, all fish can be obtained on the day of, or any time prior to, the show

Show jars must be square or rectangular and constructed from clear flat glass. External bases may be painted black or taped with plain black insulating tape. Bases may also be made from black glass

Only plain black insulating tape is to be used if show jar lids are required to be taped

Substrate in all show tanks must be of any natural medium, i.e. gravel, slate or sand. Unmatured substrate will not be judged. **(No tape or foblon tybe material is allowed inside the jar. No handles are allowed on jar lids, i.e. marbles, cut glass, etc. Lids must be completely flat).**

Breeders teams of four fish shall consist of FOUR fish. Two males and two females will be given preference in the final assessment. They must be a minimum of 2 calendar months old and no more than 14 calendar months old

Breeders teams of ten fish shall consist of TEN fish. Five males and five females shall be given preference in the final assessment. These are to be shown in either one split tank or two single tanks, with males in one side and females in the other side. The fish shown in the breeders ten must be a minimum of 3 calendar months old and no more than 14 calendar months old.

Breeders teams are to have date bred labels on top of the show tank, on white labels using blue or black ink

All breeders teams must be bred by the exhibitor

All exhibits must be owned by the exhibitor named on the entry form for that show

Pairs shall consist of two adult fish, one male and one female.

Trios shall consist of three adult fish of one sex.

Exhibitors wishing to add the scientific name of their fish to exhibit must use white labels, using blue or black ink, stuck to the front of the jar at the top.

Judges who are officiating at a show will be permitted to exhibit in breeders classes for the purpose of attaining a first time bred Achievement or a USA breeders certificate & for no other reason. Officiating Judges must label tank **for Certificate only**. The exhibiting Judge will not be permitted to Judge the class in which he or she is exhibiting

If an exhibitor cannot be present at a show his or her fish may be exhibited in their name by another party
